
## **Major Trends**

Rising interest rate environment: Cash rates are expected to increase this year but will remain well below the expected level of inflation. Based on the yield of 1-year government T-bills, a proxy for expected average cash yield over the next 12 months, investors can expect to earn c. 1.2% in USD, 1.1% in GBP and -0.3% in EUR cash deposits over the next year.

### **Golden Rules**

 The role of cash is primarily operational, in that a small cash allocation is necessary to facilitate portfolio management (e.g., meeting capital calls or portfolio withdrawals). Cash allocations should generally be kept as low as operationally possible. Cash has no investment role in an optimised long-term portfolio as it offers no risk premium for which we expect to be compensated.

# Exhibit 1 Cash rates are expected to rise from very




**Note:** Shaded area shows implied path of forward rates over next 12 months **Source:** Bloomberg

## 2022 Strategic Priorities

- Use cash sweeps and money market funds:
   Commercial banks are often slow to pass
   through higher rates to customers. In such
   a situation, Partners Capital will proactively
   sweep excess cash into money market funds
   or term deposits to earn higher yields.
- Make use of cash-like alternatives with higher yields: For larger cash allocations we recommend holding short duration investment-grade corporate bonds that represent an acceptable level of risk for roughly 50bps of additional yield and good liquidity.
